

Alinde Quartet

Emerging as one of the most exciting chamber groups of their generation, the Alinde Quartet has garnered top prizes at numerous international competitions ("Città di Pinerolo" and "Salieri-Zinetti") and has been invited to perform in some of Europe's most esteemed halls and festivals, including the Cologne Philharmonic Hall and Funkhaus, the Berlin Konzerthaus and the Verbier Festival.

The Alinde Quartet takes its name from a Lied by Schubert of the same title which captures the quartet's passionate search for musical truth and celebration of impermanence. Looking forward, the quartet has embarked in 2020 on a journey to record all of Schubert's quartets side by side with commissioned works inspired by their eponymous Lied in six releases on the Hänssler Classic label. Their project #Schubert200 will culminate in 2028, the 200th anniversary of Schubert's death.
